

A diamond and ruby floral spray brooch, circa 1968, realistically modelled as a flower stem, the centre of each bloom set with a round brilliant cut diamond or a ruby, with engraved textured detail to the stem, the brooch measuring 42 x 25mm, with hallmarks for 18ct gold, London 1968, and brooch pin fitting to the reverse, total weight 10.5 grams £200-300



A pair of diamond set scroll earrings, circa 1940s, in a scrolling spray design set with diamond chips (two deficient), each earring measuring 26 x 19mm, with screw back fittings, in yellow, rose and white metal testing as 14ct, total weight 6 grams £300-500






