

A late Victorian diamond-set pig brooch, sculpted as a stylised walking pig, fully encrusted with rose-cut diamonds and ruby accents for eyes, later-added brooch fittings to the reverse, unmarked metal surface testing as silver on 14ct, 3.7 x 1.9 cm, 7.6 grams. £300-500



A Victorian diamond-set shamrock ring in 18ct gold, the tapered band flush-set with three old-cut diamonds, along with engravings arranged as a trefoil clover, Birmingham 1898, size N, 4.8 grams. £250-350




Joseph Cheret. A pewter chamberstick, with figural mask carrying handle and oval-shaped dish, the nozzle supported by a cast cherub. 15.5cm high x 18cm wide. Signed and numbered; 'Joseph Cheret' and with a foundry mark 'Soleau Paris 1894.' £500-700



419 A Viennese ormolu and hard enamel horse-drawn coach form trinket box, Vienna, C1880S, the body of the carriage with enamel "Romantic" panels of lovers in landscapes with hinged cover, trunk and footbox with velvet-lined interiors and glazed with bevelled glass panels, 18 cm wide x 9.5 cm deep x 10 cm overall height.

Notes from the vendor "In 1938 on Kristellnacht (October 9th) when the Nazi's raided homes and shops and burned down synagoguesMy grandparents maid had informed on them to her boyfriend who was in the SS. They raided their apartment, stealing and smashing things as they went, and the coach was thrown out of the window. My uncle, then aged 8, was devastated and after they'd left he ran down to the street to retrieve it. It was amazingly undamaged. Both my uncle and my mother who was 3 years older were sent on the kinder transport to UK. My mother was taken to a Dr. Barnados home before being re-united with her mother who arrived 9 months later.



My grandparents also managed to escape. First my grandmother, who came via the Red Cross as a 'domestic' which was one of the only ways of getting in. Then my grandfather who was smuggled through Amsterdam with his brother in the boot of a commercial vehicle and caught a ship to England. On arrival they were both arrested as enemy aliens and interned in the Isle of Man until 1942." £2,000-3,000





An unusual cased pair of silver-plated scimitar fish servers and the pierced blade with a scene after Walton, with the somewhat incongruous appearance of an igloo in the rear ground. 32 cm long the knife. £80-120



A silver three-piece tea set, circular with applied scroll and shell motifs, a leaf-capped spout and handles, the teapot with ebonised handle, Birmingham 1929 and 1930 by Docker & Burn Ltd, 553g. 16.3ozt. £300-500



A probably Spanish silver ivy-shaped hors d'oeuvre dish with three smaller side dishes, a serving spoon with galleon terminal, a tea strainer and stand, a pair of condiments, 564 grams, 18.1 ozt gross weight of weighable silver. £200-300



A collection of nine assorted silver mustard pots and a single George III slated oval salt. All with liners and condiment spoons, some plated. Gross weight weighable, 468 grams, 15ozt. £300-500



A pair of Danish silver grape scissors, by P. Hertz, with stylised beaded and foliate decoration to handles; together with an Irish silver sifter ladle, Dublin 1813 by Richard Sawyer, four Scottish dessert spoons, with monograms engraved to terminals, Edinburgh 1800 Robert Gray, two pairs of sauce ladles and one other, and a quantity of mixed flatware including fish eaters and servers (blades and tines only) Gross weight. 2380 grams, 76.5 ozt. £1,000-1,500





A Victorian silver taperstick and snuffer, Sheffield 1845 by Walker & Knowles (specialist taper and candlestick makers), with removable drip pans above a double knop stem and an ogee moulded square base. 4.1 ozt, 127 grams, 14cm high. £150-250



A George I style bachelor tea set, of low-bellied form, the teapot with a domed cover, knop finial, and fruitwood handle, London 1934 by C.S.Harris. 756 grams, 24.3ozt £600-800



A cased pair of Victorian silver apostle spoons, Sheffield 1899 by Walker and Hall; together with a four-piece silver-mounted dressing table set comprising a hand mirror, a hairbrush, a pair of clothes brushes, and a silver topped toilet jar, Chester 1902. Gross weight weighable 178 grams, 5.7ozt. £150-250



A three-piece silver tea set, of panelled circular form, the teapot with a wooden handle and knop finial, Sheffield 1959 by Mappin and Webb, together with two pairs of sugar tongs. Gross weight 953 grams, 30.6 ozt. £600-800



A pair of Victorian apostle spoons, the terminals depicting St Peter, London 1894 by William Hutton and Sons; together with a pierced circular bonbon dish, Sheffield 1896, and a boxed set of crystal glass butter dishes with two butter knives. Gross weight 185 grams, 5.90zt. £100-150





A Victorian outsize silver-topped and domed glass inkwell, London 1894 by George Brace (?), the hinged pomel cover inscribed "Peter, May 7th 1895, the glass well with a deep hobnail cut base, 17 cm diameter x 17 cm overall height. £200-300



Gerald Benney - a cased silver gilt and enamelled goblet, the bell-shaped bowl with red guilloché enamel over a textured ground, gilt interior, cream enamel stem and circular spreading base engraved 'The first 10 are the worst'. London 1972 by Gerald Benney with master enameller's mark for Robert Vidal. 15.2cm high; 307 grams, 9.9ozt £1,000-1,500



432 Edward, Edward junior, John & William Barnard, a good silver gilt sugar urn of basket form, London 1843, the faux basket woven form with meandering fruiting vines and leaves about its body and domed circular base, (Liner Missing), 16.6 ozt / 470.6 grams, 14.0cm diameter x 14.0cm high. £500-700



A pair of Spanish "Astrain" silver fruit dishes, 20th century, each with a shaped outline and heavily chased and polished decoration, 596 grams, 19.1 ozt, 29 cm overall diameter. £300-500



A Victorian Grecian revival three-piece tea set, comprising teapot, twin handled sugar vase, milk jug, each with finely engraved classical scenes within clasped acanthus bands and beaded borders, monogram engraved within a circular cartouche to the teapot, the slightly domed cover with an urn finial. A Spanish silver mezuzah with relief decoration, 20th century, 17 cm long, a Spanish silver hinged covered box and other small items of silver, 595 grams, 19.1 ozt. gross weight of weighable silver. £250-350



A Gabriel Larriva of Cordoba silver chamber candlestick, late 19th century, Spanish silver colonial style ewer, 20th century and other silver items, 618 grams, 19.8 ozt gross weight of weighable silver. £200-300



A matched Kings pattern canteen; comprising eight double struck table forks and three dessert forks en suite, Victorian mixed dates and makers, together with eight table spoons, six dessert forks, a dessert spoon, four tea spoons, single struck, Glasgow marks, mixed dates and makers, six teaspoons, Glasgow marks 1824, together with a set of twelve electroplated table forks. A suite of four silver pedestal bonbon dishes, Birmingham 1928, by Blanckensee and son, with serpentine rims and pierced decoration, over loaded spreading feet. 9.5 cm diameter. £150-250



An Edwardian silver teapot and hot water pot, circular, partfluted with shell and gadrooned borders and ebonised angled handles and fluted finials. Birmingham 1901 by Elkington and Co. Gross weight 1507 grams, 48.5ozt £400-600



A silver biscuit box, oval with reeded borders and reeded side handles, applied cartouche to centre with a nymph; Sheffield 1924 by Thomas Bradbury & Sons Ltd. 23cm x 12cm x 8.5cm. 649 grams, 20.88ozt £600-800



A silver salver, of shaped square outline with incuse corners, on four volute scroll feet, Birmingham 1939 by Adie Bros. 26cm wide, 684g, 21.2ozt. £300-500



An Indian Kutch silver inclined teapot and matching cream jug, late 19th century, with typical intricate chasing, and a cobra handle, together with four Roberts & Belk epns hot water jugs, two sugars, and a cream jug, all made for the colonial Indian market. 592 grams. 19 ozt weight of Kutch silver. A Victorian tea caddy spoon, fiddle pattern with scalloped bowl, Exeter 1856 by Josiah Williams & Co., a George III silver cream jug, with repairs, two further cream jugs; five napkin rings and sundry other items including a pair of Italian base metal and white metal tongs, a pair of silver spill vases with weighted bases, Gross weight ex. tongs 671 grams, 21.6 ozt. £300-500



- Gerald Benney a limited edition Silver Jubilee dish. The commemorative Armada style dish, with depressed silver-gilt centre, engraved with the Royal Coat of Arms of the United Kingdom and commemorative inscription. Designed for Carrington by Gerald Benney, and numbered 79 from a limited edition of 1000. In fitted case, with paperwork. 13.5 cm diam. 197.2 grams, 6.3ozt. £250-350
- A Victorian agricultural silver trophy cup and cover; the urnshaped bowl with leaf-capped scrolling side handles, a globular knopped- stem and semi-spherical base with three leaf-capped hoof feet and serpent entwined loop handles, the cover with a cast cow finial, gilt interior and chased throughout with trailing acorns and oak leaves, vacant cartouches to each side, Sheffield 1881 by W W Harrison & Co, 35.5cm high; together with a small trophy cup with commemorative inscription, and two medals agricultural medals in fitted case, won for Wensleydales and cream cheese production. Gross weight of the trophies 1556 grams, 50ozt



The Rowntree and Wills families, to whom these medals and one of the trophy cups were presented, were pioneers in the making and initiation of factory production of cheese, with the aim of achieving consistently high and even quality. £800-1,200

Two presentation pieces with associations to the agricultural communities of Wensleydale and Kirby Overblow. A cased soup ladle, Old English pattern, with commemorative inscription to the terminal and bowl. Sheffield 1911 by John Henry Potter; together with a fruit serving spoon, also with a commemorative inscription to the interior of the bowl. Sheffield 1925 by John Round. Gross weight 360 grams, 11.6ozt. The Rowntree and Wills families, to whom this spoon and ladle were presented, were pioneers in the making and initiation of factory production of cheese, with the aim of achieving consistently high and even quality. £200-300









A three-piece silver teaset, circular with beaded gadrooned borders and leaf-capped scroll handles, the teapot with a flat hinged cover and cast bud finial and fruitwood handle, each piece on four bun feet. Sheffield 1918 by James Dixon and Sons. 1457 grams, 46.8ozt £500-700



A Spanish silver leaf-form dish and three matching dishes, 20th century, together with a further Spanish bread dish, 568.5 grams, 18.2 ozt gross weight of silver. 26 cm diameter of the largest item. £200-300



A cased pair of Victorian fish servers; fiddle and thread pattern with foliate pierced blades. London 1871 by George Adams, for Chawner and Co. 323g, 10.4 ozt £250-350



A collection of Sterling silver and white metal items, accessories, and a small quantity of silver plate and a Givenchy white metal and "Lapis Blue" fountain pen £200-300



A silver jewellery box, kidney-shaped with engine-turned cover and velvet interior and on four leaf-capped pad feet, Birmingham 1918 by white metal snuff box (probably silver) and a novelty silver rocking horse £300-400





A silver part canteen of fiddle pattern flatware, monograms engraved to terminals, comprising six table forks and twelve dessert forks; together with five George III Old English pattern tablespoons, six matched fiddle pattern condiment spoons, and a quantity of mixed fiddle pattern and other flatware. Mixed dates and makers, mainly George III and Victorian. Gross weight 2236 grams, 80ozt £1,000-1,500



An Aprey and Co, boxed silver spring-loaded bookmark (Pat 257529), London 1972 by Asprey & Co, together with other silver items including gravy boats, small trophy dressing table appointments and other items, 452 grams, 14.5 ozt gross weight. £300-500



A Spanish silver Challa dish decorated with wheat sheaves, another with pierced foliate and squirrell decoration, a cigarette box, and a small pair of candlesticks, 422 grams, 13.5 oz gross weight of weighable silver. £200-300



A set of four loaded silver Corinthian column squat candlesticks, London 1892, by Edward (William) Hutton & Sons, each with removable drip pans, on stepped and beaded square bases, bearing a presentation inscription for Henry Harrison, September 1891. Loaded bases, 15 cm overall height. £200-300



A sterling silver Hanukkah menorah, decorated with the decologue below a crown, flanked by lions and fitted with eight oil jars and two helpers, bearing import marks and together with a silver yad, a small pair of candlesticks and a telescopic shamash, 27cm wide x 21cm overall height, the primary item, 875 grams, 28.1 ozt combined weight, yad and shamash included (hollow handles). £300-500





A Spanish silver circular footed fruit bowl, 20th century, with deeply moulded, circular form with scroll and shell outline, 447 grams, 14.3 ozt, 31 cm overall diameter. £200-300



A Victorian cased silver scent bottle, of cylindrical form, with engraved foliate decorations all over, hinged cover open to reveal a glass stopper and gilt interior, by Sampson Mordan & Co., London 1881; a silver carved calling card case, polished body engraved with name of the vessel "R.M.S. Guelph" dated 1907, Birmingham 1906; a silver patience card table box, of rectangular form, red leather lined and loaded base, by William Comyns & Sons, London 1905. (3) £100-150



A Victorian cased silver cauldron, salts (liners missing) and corresponding salt spoons, Birmingham 1890 by Hayes Bros, a cigarette box, four sweetmeat dishes, and a quantity of other silver flatware, 500 grams, 16 ozt gross weight of weighable silver. £300-500



A matched three-piece silver coffee/tea set, by Charles S Green & Co. Ltd, Birmingham 1948 & 1959; comprising a teapot, a coffee pot and a hot water jug, acanthus leaf-capped spouts, urn-shaped finials on domed covers, scrolled fruitwood handles, on stepped circular foot; total weight of items 2450.5 grams. (78.78 ozt) £400-600



A mixed group of silver flatware, and another items; to include four fiddle pattern teaspoons with crested finials, by William Chawner II, London 1823; a pair of Old English pattern tablespoons with monogrammed finials by William Eley I, William Fearn & William Chawner, London 1810; a matched set of six Irish silver fiddle pattern table forks, by different maker's and mixed dates 1830, 1831 and 1834; other loose silver spoons and a set of butterknives with filled handles; and fruit knives with stainless steel blades and mother of pearl handles. Total weighable 488.1 grams (15.69 ozt) £250-350





A silver-mounted tusk-type page turner with faux tortoise shell blade, probably Spanish, 32cm long, together with a silver-bladed letter knife, another 20th century silver letter knife, a Victorian cast silver caddy spoon, and a Victorian silver fiddle pattern Stilton scoop. 142 grams, 4.5 ozt £150-250



A Soviet Russian, vintage silver gilt (84) and niello decorated part teaset, first half of the 20th century, with a two-handled sugar, and six tea glasses, each item with green glass liners decorated with "front of furnace" enamel flowers. 722 grams, 23.2 ozt gross weight £400-600



Gabriel Larriva of Cordoba, a late 19th-century Spanish silver rectangular serving tray with a Compostella shell and scroll border, the centre with an elaborate escutcheon-shaped boss. 775 grams, 24 ozt, 39cm x 31cm. £300-500



An Irish silver potato ring, of traditional Irish form, circular with bar-pierced and swag chased sides, and later wooden liner; Dublin 1928 by T Weir & Sons. 10cm high x 20 cm wide at base. 328 grams, 10.5ozt £300-500



Puiforcat - A French part canteen of Moderne flatware, double struck, with foliage and trailing vines. Comprising nine table spoons, nine table forks, and a dessert spoon and fork, together with seven French silver-mounted horn table knives and a carving set en suite. Circa 1880. Gross weight weighable 1669 grams, 53.6 ozt £1,000-1,500





- A large and impressive silver-plated Elkington & Co of Birmingham/London, exhibition standard table centre with typical exotic animals, including a giraffe, ostrich, and antelope browsing the branches of a tall tree or seated on the domed base, bearing a presentation inscription below a Wakes knot and dated 1853, bearing a factory plaque below with a concurring date of publication, fitted a large frosted and intaglio cut glass trumpert insert. 35 cm wide x 67 cm overall height, together with somewhat similar but smaller silver-plated table centres. (4) £150-200
- 470 Elkington. A substantial silver-plated table centrepiece, depicting an ostrich, a giraffe and a recumbent antelope on a rocky base, under entwined palm trees which support a large cut glass bowl. Elkington and Co, bearing plate marks for 1862. £200-300
