

A large German pine dolls house, late 19th century, the painted red brick front with six windows, opening to reveal three floors, (kitchen and pantry, sitting room and a bedroom, containing dolls and an extensive collection of furniture and accessories (various dates, but most period), 140 cm high x 78 cm x 41 cm. £1,000-1,500



A late 19th century German wooden Noah's Ark, likely original paintwork, 31.5 cm high x 56 cm x 156 cm, together with six painted wood figures (Noah and others), and a collection of mis-matched animals, of varying size and material. £300-500



Antonin Münzberg (1871-1954) Czechoslovkia, an early 20th century toy puppet theatre, realistically modelled with card background scenery and cloth stage curtain, together with a set of conforming and period marionette puppets, the stage 66 cm high x 89 cm wide x 50 cm deep. £400-600



An Ayres type dappled grey painted rocking horse, with pine base and runners, with real horsehair and brown leather mounts, indistinct printed marks to base, 118 cm high x 126 cm x 41 cm. £300-500



A Leeway wooden horse-drawn farm cart, early to mid 20th century, with opening back, metal spoked wheels with white tyres, maker's name stencilled to back and carved and painted grey horse on wheeled platform, 24 cm high x 45 cm long, together with a further pull-along wooden horse, 28 cm x 23 cm.

A group of three Schuco felt-covered tinplate clockwork toy, modelled as clowns in red costumes, comprising a drummer and violinist, the third swinging a toy mouse, each without a box, 11 cm high.

Four assorted large mohair teddy bears, each with jointed limbs, early 20th century and later, one with partially working 'growler' sound, the largest circa 61 cm. £80-120



A German bisque head Marotte doll, with working musical sound, on original wooden pole with bells attached, incised marks to rear of head, 33 cm. £100-150





An unusual WWI era Huntley & Palmers sentry box biscuit tin, depicting soldiers from England, Russia, France and Belgium, 18 cm high, together with a further Huntley & Palmers biscuit tin, modelled a china display cabinet, 18 cm high, another similar modelled as chest of drawers (unnamed), 21.5 cm high, a Sutton's Seeds tin, 11.5 cm x 20 cm, and a Turnwright's Toffee De-Light tin, modelled as a suitcase, 8.5 cm x 26 cm. An early 20th century small child's wooden rocking horse, of typical form, with dapple grey horse, on a painted wood base, 62 cm high x 99 cm wide. £100-150



A mid 20th-century child's push-a-long Triangtois Dairy Cart, green and yellow painted wood with red metal wheels and rubber tyres, fitted with a metalware large milk pail, and a collection of painted wood milk bottles, 47 cm high x 46 cm wide. £200-300

An early 20th century scratch built wooden sailing boat on stand, 60 cm x 55 cm, together with another smaller (later built), 43 cm high, and two toy drums with assorted sticks. £80-120





A small wooden toy rocking horse, dapple grey with real horsehair, 86 cm high x 91 cm x 34 cm. £100-200



An early 20th century mohair teddy bear, with working musical box (playing a lullaby), 41 cm, together with two further teaddy bears, the largest c. 45 cm.

A United State MAR Toys tin plate clockwork soldier, with drum, 23 cm, together with two tinplate clockwork ducks, the largest 14 cm high.




A collection of Burnett Ltd (and others) tinplate money boxes, modelled as traditional red post office boxes, the tallest 16 cm, together with two Hornby Series tinplate station platform sections, each for 'Ripon', a children's china tea set, decorated with bears, and a Remanco miniature clothes mangle. £100-150



A child's Triang washstand set, comprising a green and redpainted mangle, on four rubber mounted wheels, 49 cm high x 46 cm, two metal buckets and a wooden washboard, together with a Victorian sprung dolls pram, English, with three metal spoke wheels, lined carriage and foot-well, oil cloth hood and turned wood handle, 73 cm high, and a small mohair teddy bear.

An early 20th century child's sailor's uniform, comprising an 'HMS New Zealand' hat, undershirt, trousers, tunic and scarf, the tunic circa 45 cm from collar to hem. £80-120



A collection of early 20th century children's toys, to include a folding wash stand, kitchen pan and jug, toilet mirror, abacus, and asoorted wicker baskets. £50-80



An early 20th century clockwork elephant, fabric covered with tinplate tusks, 9 cm high x 11.5 cm long, together with a Schuco tinplate clockwork toy, modelled as a bear holding aloft a mouse, 13 cm, and a further similar toy, a dog with a boot in its mouth.
